

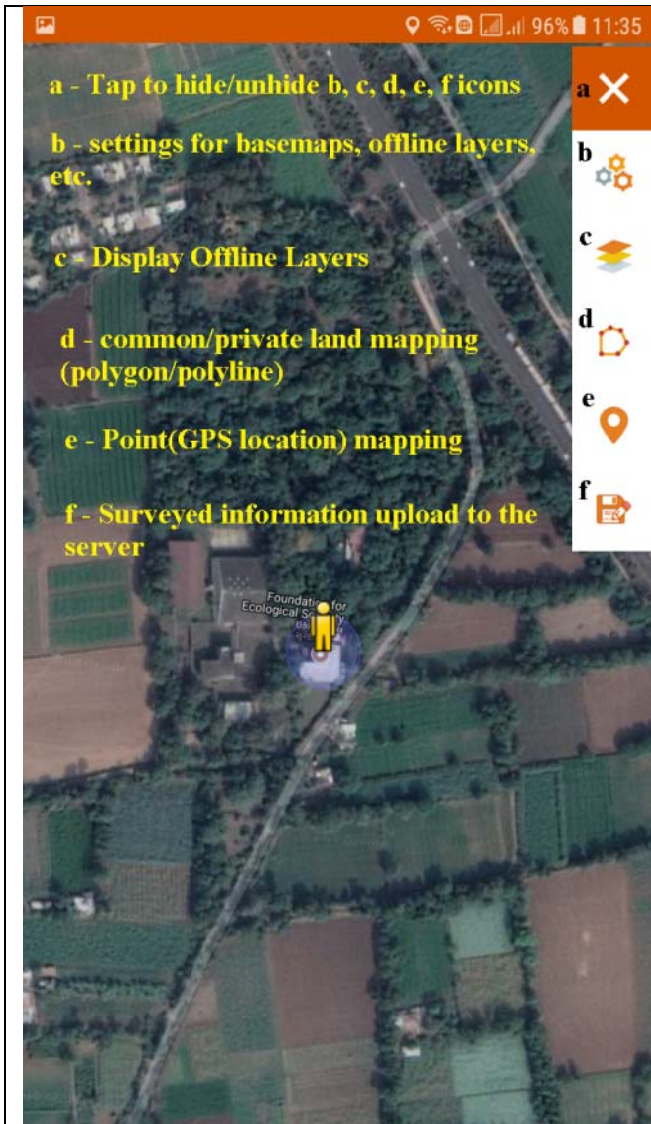

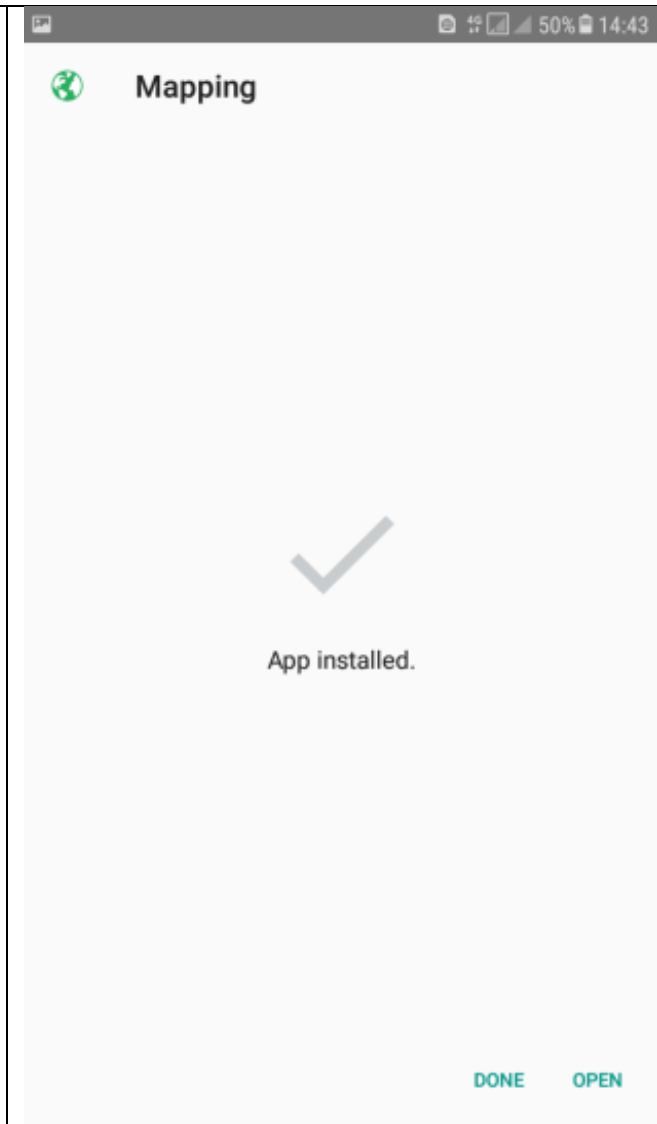
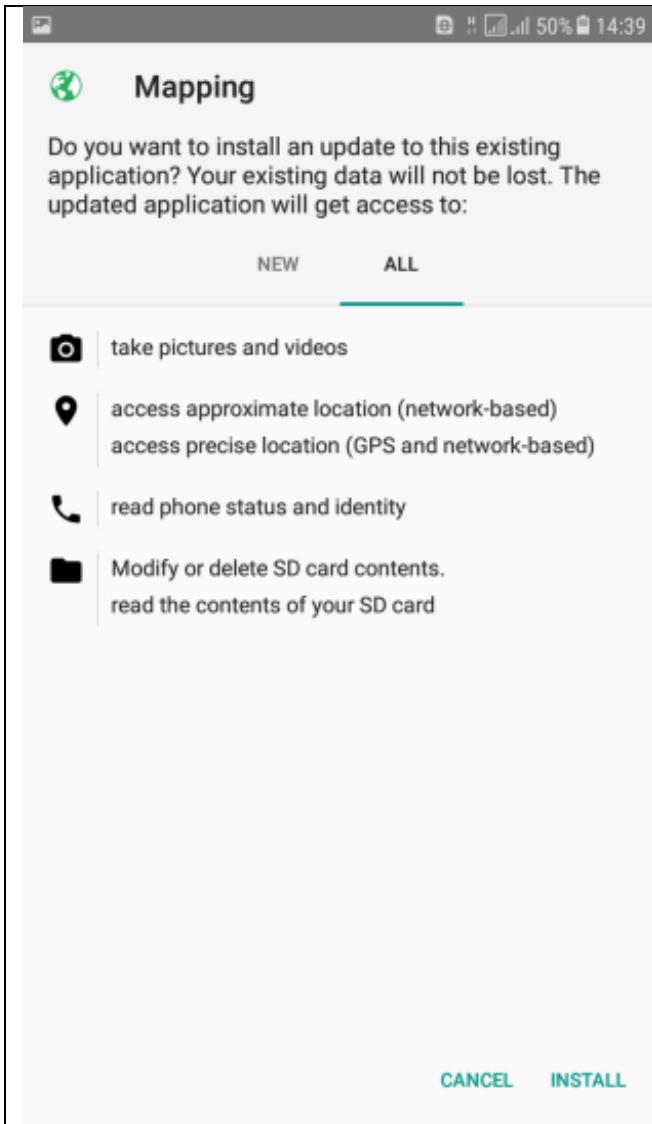


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- Mapping of Common/Private land can be initiated using  icon after getting good accuracy of GPS. Two options will be displayed (Automatic/Manual Mode) tapping by . Manual mode will work with user input while Automatic Mode digitizes land as per the device movement automatically as per the time interval chosen by user.

-  upload surveyed data to server.

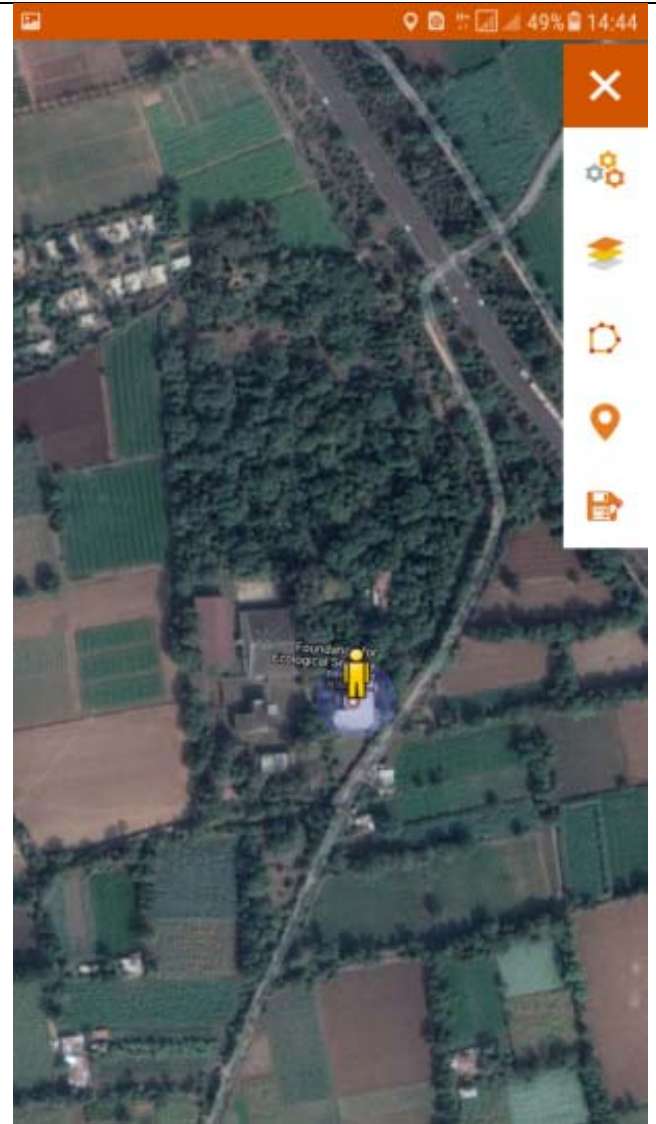

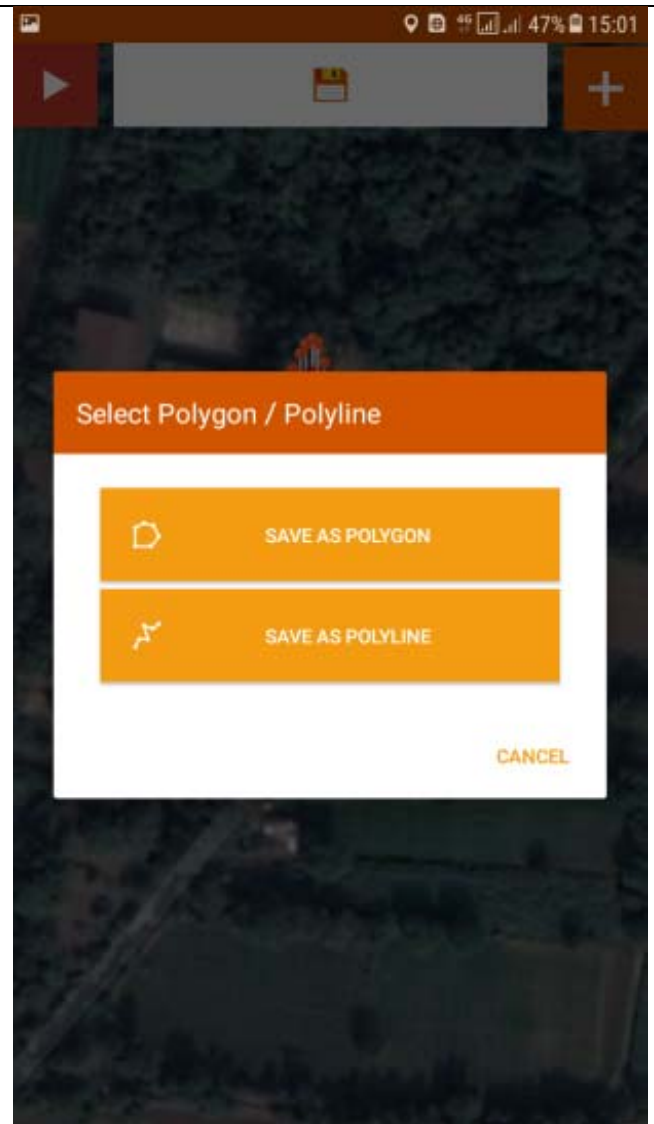
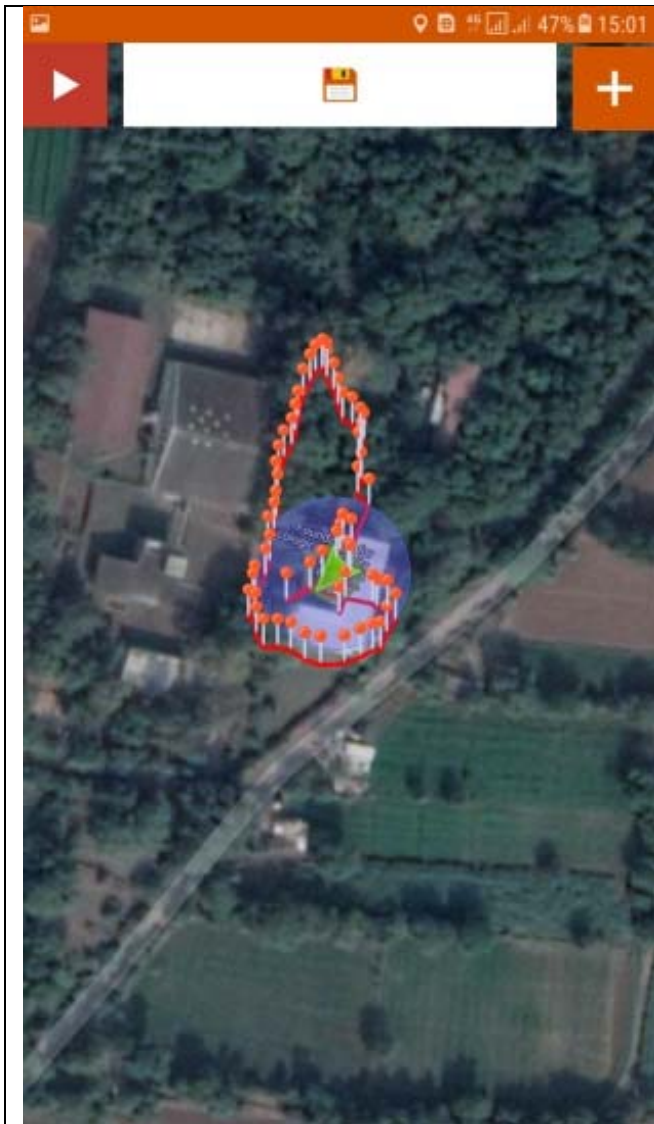
tap ⚙️ to start mapping



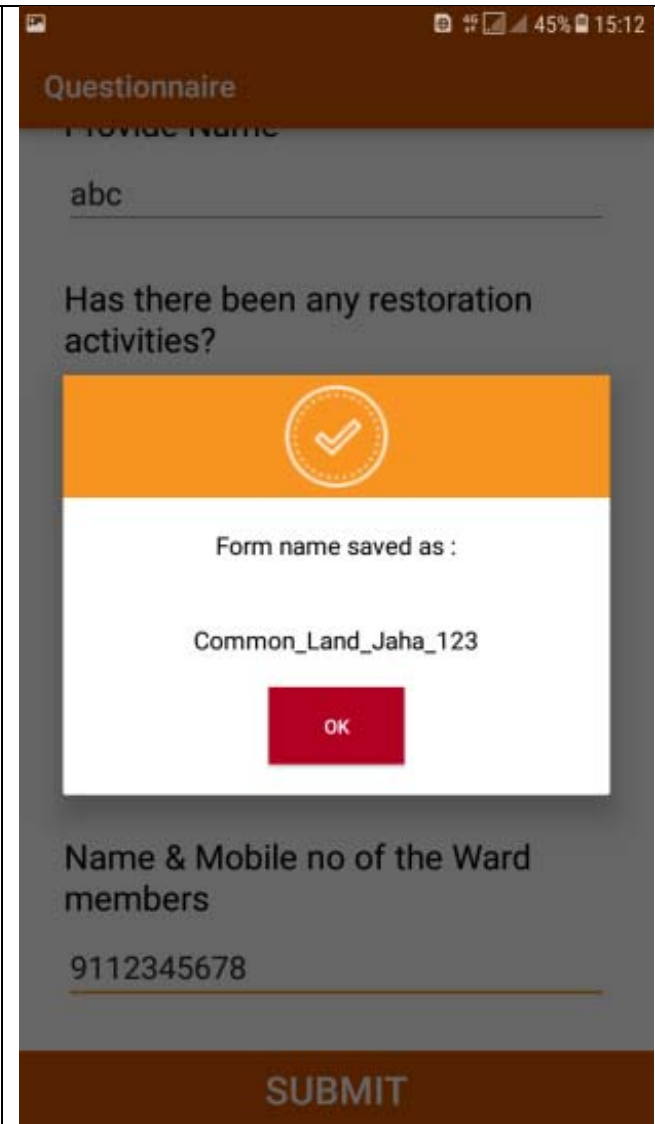
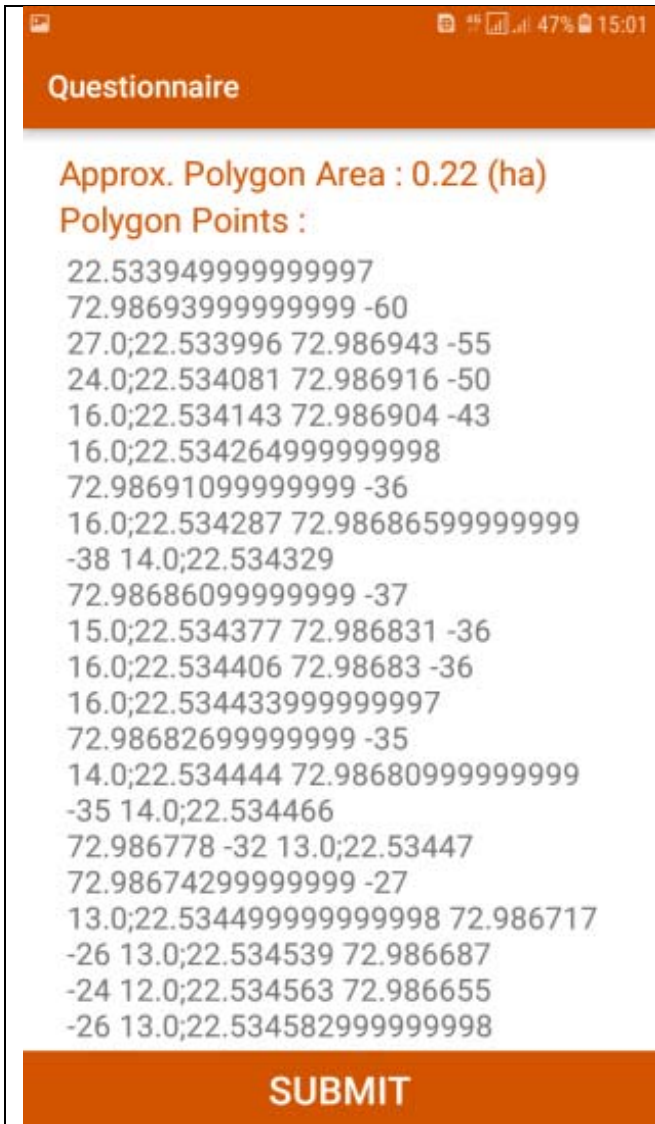
it gives two options to map common/private land.

Press save button to save as a polygon/polyline.

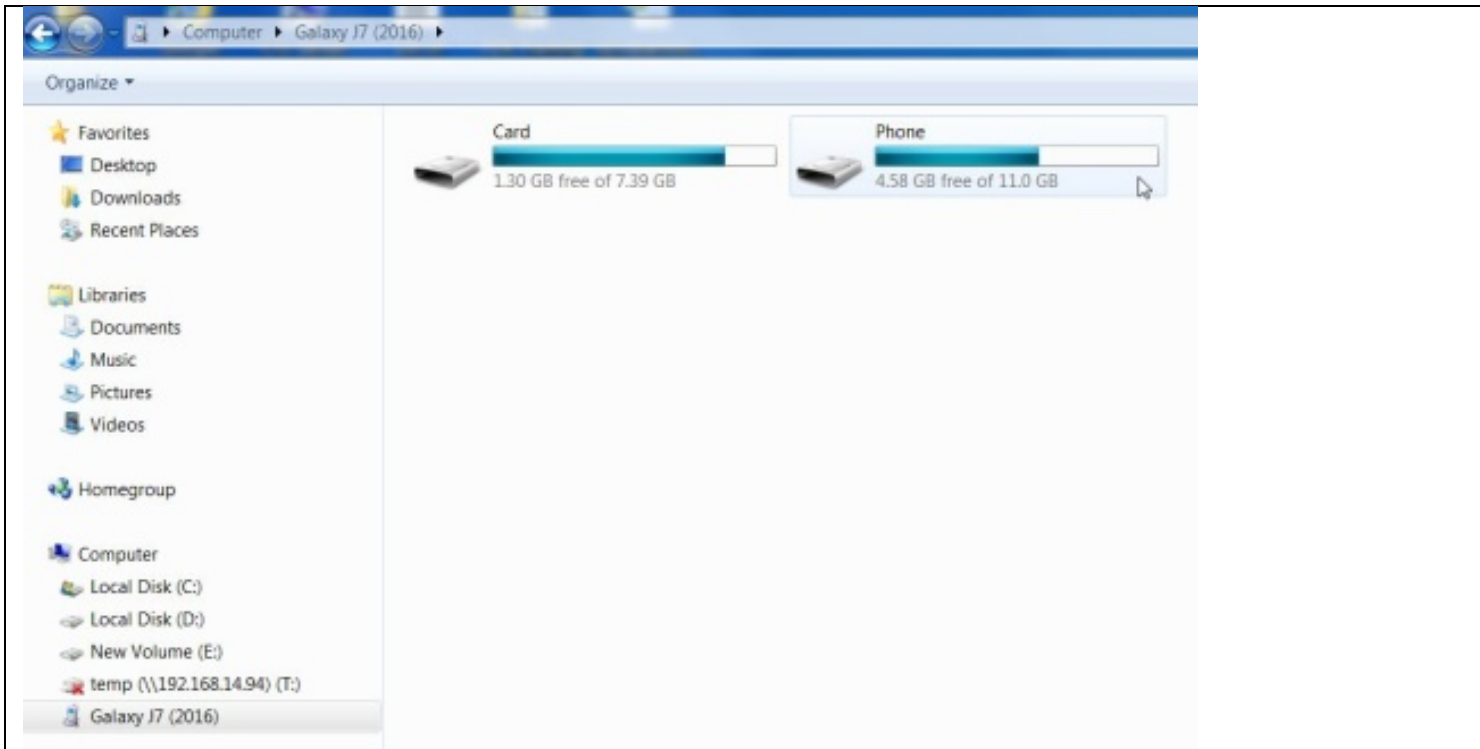

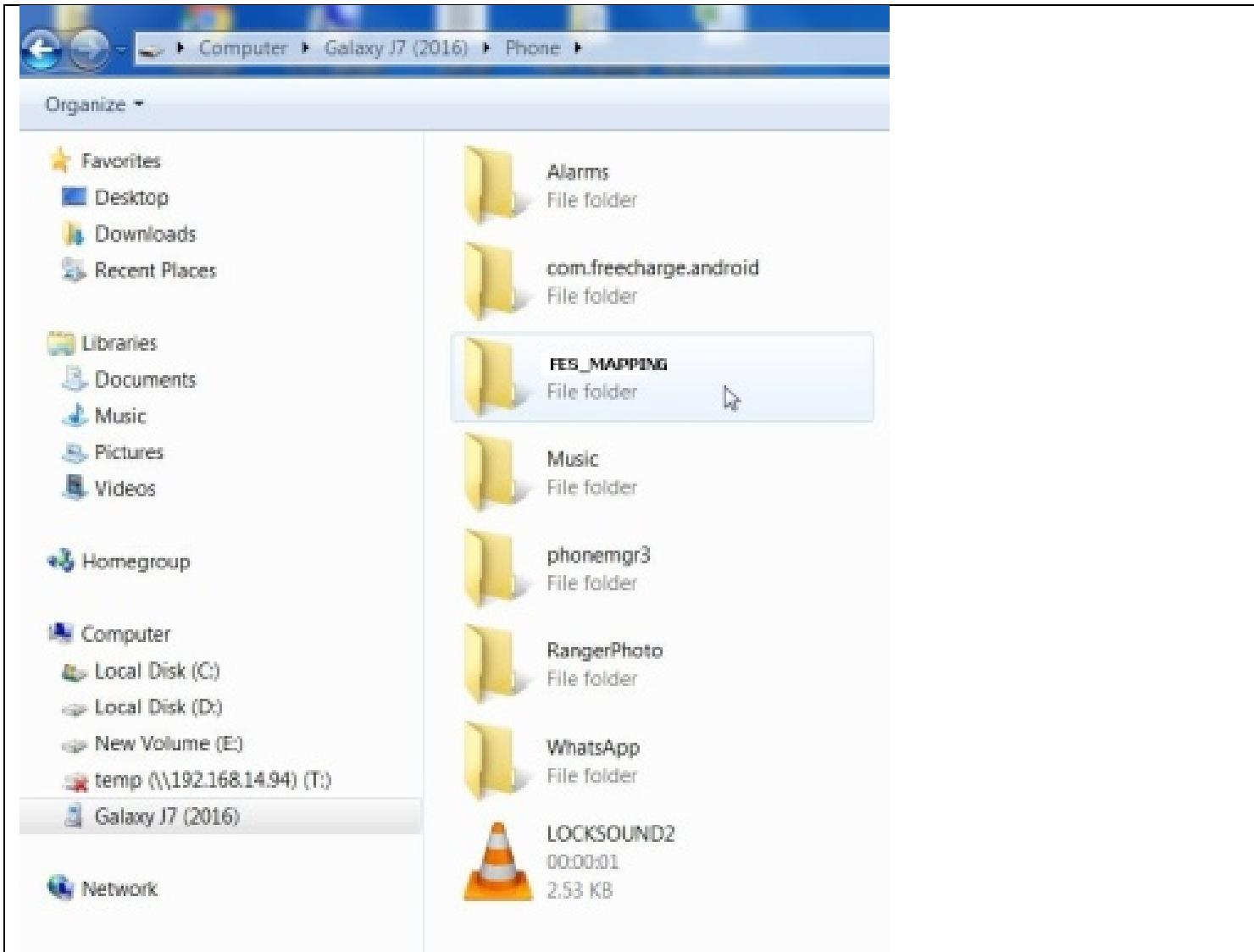

Questionnaire form of Common/Private land mapping. This form can be modified as per the user requirement.

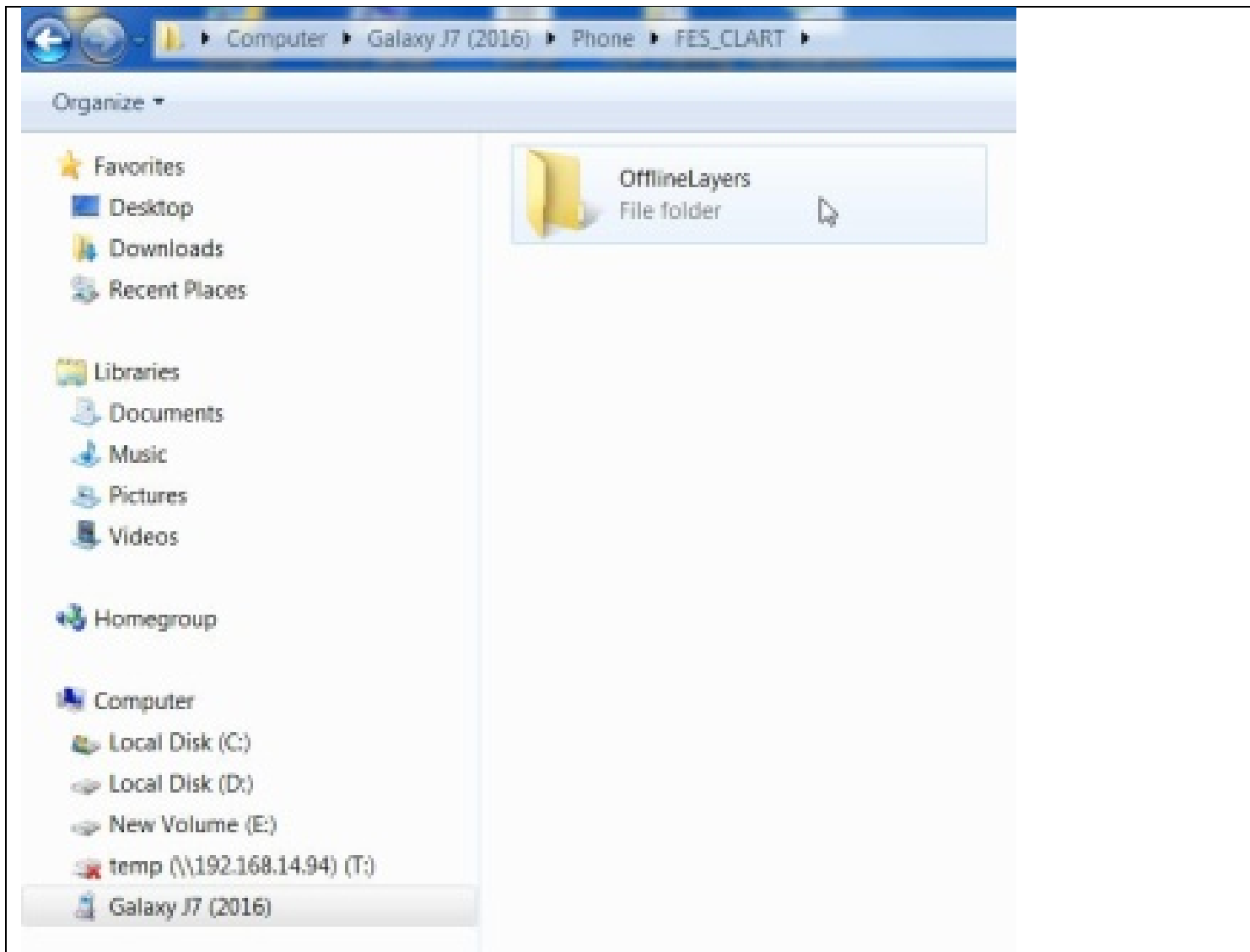
Process to store Offline Maps as a "Offline Layers"



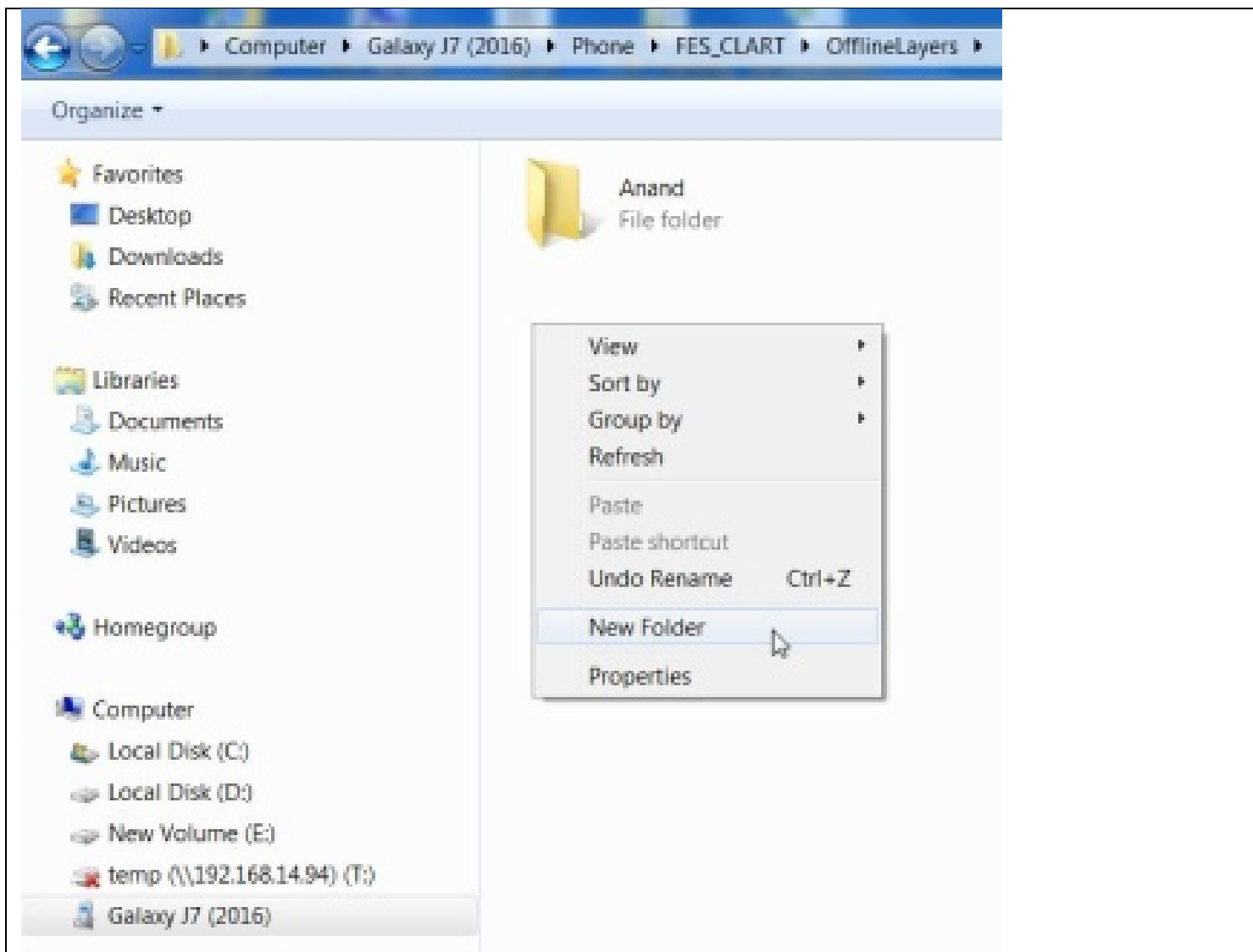
Step 1: Connect the android tablet/mobile to computer using a USB cable and open tablet/mobile drive on explorer.



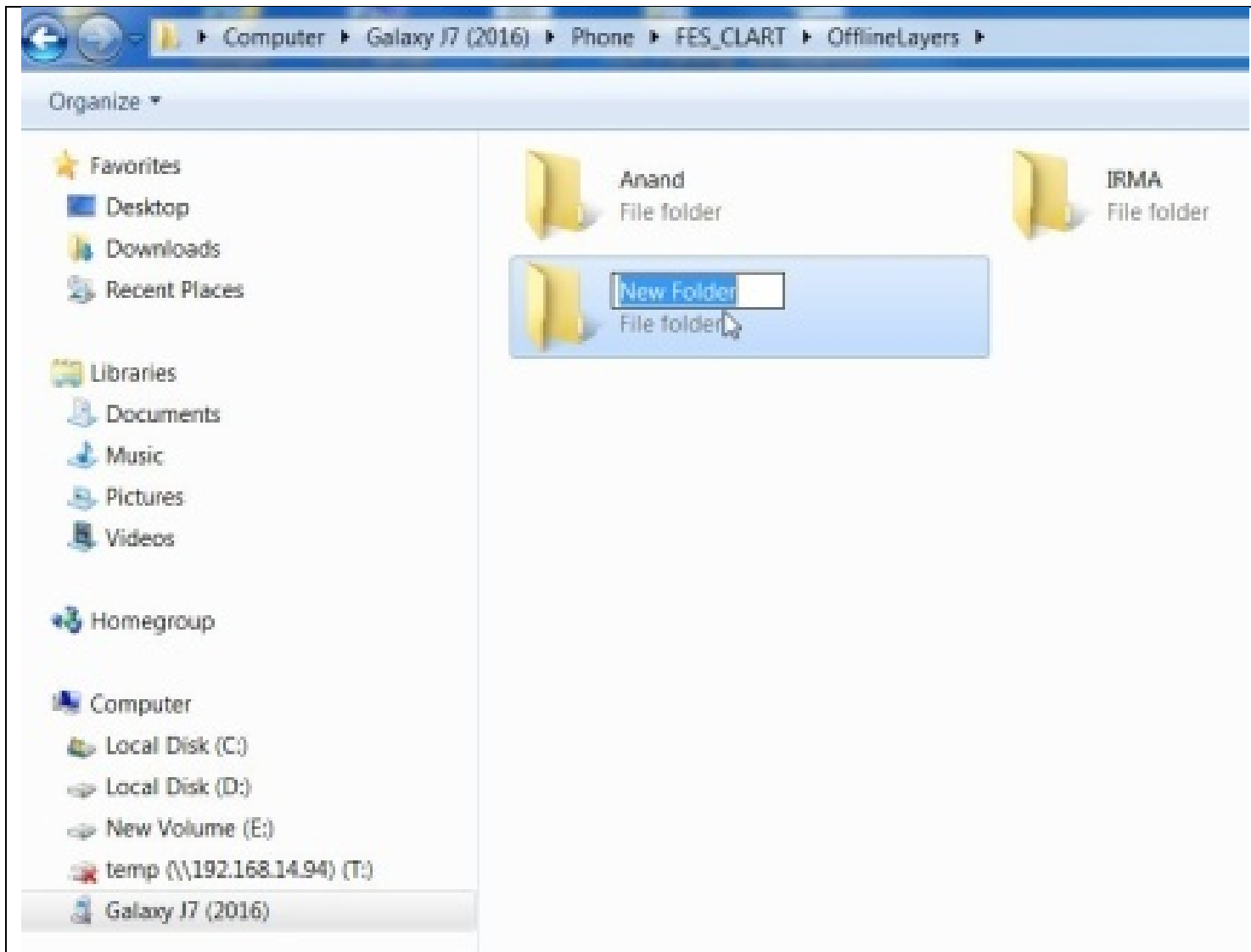
Step 2: Find "FES MAPPING" Installation folder.



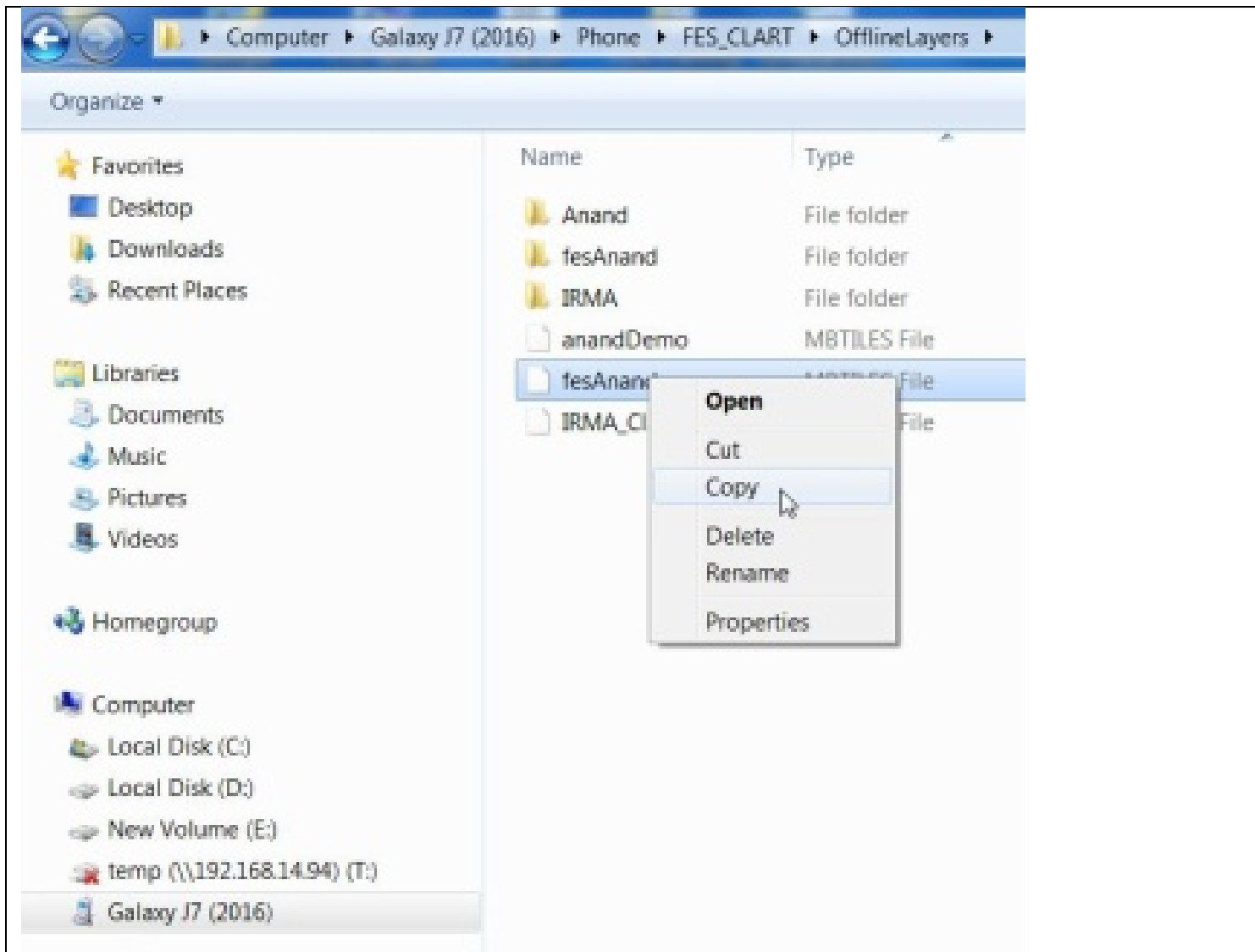
Step 3: 'Offline Layers' .



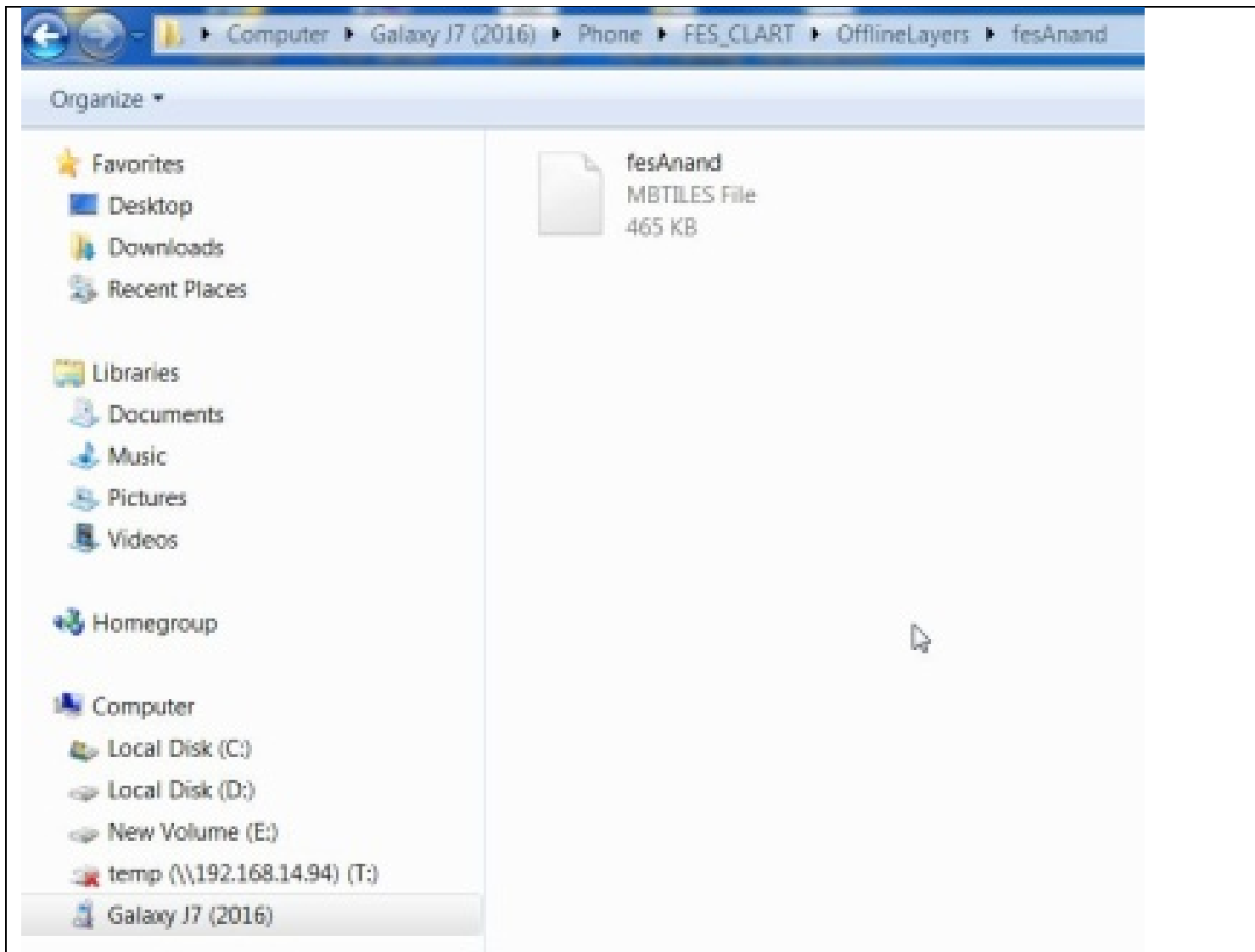
Step 4: Create 'New Folder' inside "Offline Layers" folder



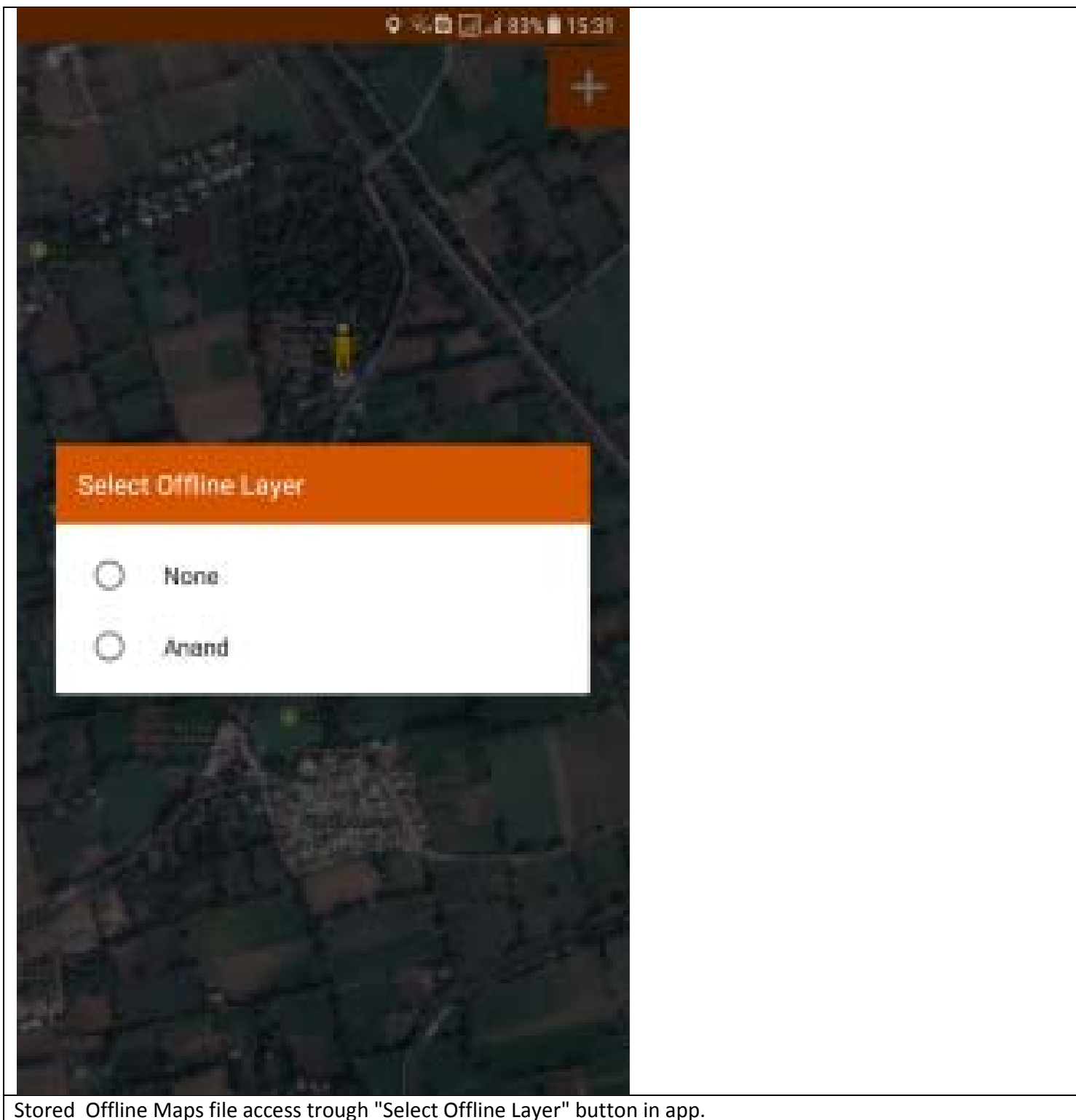
Step 5: Rename 'New Folder' to desire name
